CONSTRUCTION/RENOVATIONS Before starting any work, call the municipal office at 450-242-2704 to see if a permit or certificate of authorization is required, ex. culverts, wells, woodcuts, septic systems etc.

BURNING BRUSH Before lighting a fire or starting to burn branches, leaves or grass, call 450-242-1222 to know the risk level and prevention measures. Municipal by-law #312, fines & fire department intervention charges applicable
BE VIGILANT!

GARBAGE During the months of January – May inclusively & October-December inclusively household bulky garbage will be picked up every second week on a Monday and during the months of June-September inclusively it will be weekly on a Monday. Building materials & car parts are **NOT ACCEPTED**. Garbage must be in a covered container or holding box if placed by the roadside before Monday morning. Part time residents please flag your garbage for pick-up. **DEAD ANIMALS** are not to be included in garbage.

RECYCLING is every **2nd Monday**, during the months of January-May inclusively & October – December inclusively.

During the months of **June – September inclusively it will be every 2nd Wednesday**. Use transparent bags. Glass, plastic & metals rinsed well. Cardboard must be flattened.

DOG LICENSES are compulsory in West Bolton and are available at the municipal office at a cost of \$20.00 each. Infractions to the by-law could result in fines. Dogs must be kept under control at all times. **It is suggested that all dogs wear a nylon collar with the guardian's telephone # with area code marked in permanent marker.**

MINISTER OF ENVIRONMENT Obliges septic systems be pumped out once every two years for full time residents and once every four years for part time residents.

9-1-1 EMERGENCY SERVICE operational in West Bolton.

BY-LAW #324 enacts a **charge** for the intervention of the fire department responding to a faulty false fire alarm system or an alarm set off for no useful reason. The **charge (very expensive)** is equal to costs billed to the municipality by the Brome Lake fire department. There are no exceptions.

BY-LAW #291 - CIVIC NUMBERS it is **obligatory** to post civic numbers **clearly visible** from the road, infractions to the by-law could result in fines.

BY-LAW RM#110 ALARM SYSTEMS allows no more than 2 false alarms in 12 months

BY-LAW #314 SMOKE ALARMS was adopted February 2006, available at municipal office for consultation

MUNICIPAL ELECTION non-domiciled electors must submit written request to municipality to be on electoral list. Forms are available at the municipal office.
