**SECOND DRAFT BY-LAW # 264-2008-09-01
AMENDING ZONING BY-LAW #264-2008**

To any interested persons of zones PRES-3, RF-4, RF-5, REC-3 and MIX-1, eligible to sign a request to participate in a referendum.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that:

1. Following the public consultation meeting held on March 2nd 2009, council adopted on April 6th 2009, the “Second Draft By-law #264-2008-09-01” amending Zoning By-law #264-2008 in order to:
 - **Enlarge municipal zone PRES-3 from a part of the zone RF-4 (between Tuer rd and Bolton Pass rd).**
2. This second Draft By-law contains provisions that could be the object of a request on behalf of interested persons in the concerned zone and in contiguous zones to submit the by-law which contains these provisions to their approval in conformity to “*An act respecting elections & referendums in municipalities*”.
3. **To be valid, all requests must:**
 - Clearly indicate the provision that is referred to and the zone from which it originates;
 - Be signed by at least 12 interested persons from the zone from which it originates or by at least the majority of them if the number of interested persons in the zone does not exceed 21;
 - Be received at the municipal office no later than May 7th, 2009 at 4h00 pm.
4. Information explaining which interested persons have the right to sign a request and on the manner in which a legal person may exercise the right to sign an application can be obtained, at no cost, at the municipal office located at 9 Town Hall rd, West Bolton. Business hours are from Monday to Friday between 9h00 AM and 4:00 PM.
5. Any provision set out in the second Draft By-law that is not the object of a valid request could be included in a By-law and will not be subject to approval from eligible voters.
6. Any person may consult at the municipal office, the illustration & limits of the zone affected by the second by-law project along with the contiguous zones.
7. Any person can obtain without cost, a copy of this second Draft By-law. The project can be consulted at the municipal office, 9 Town Hall, West Bolton, Monday to Friday between 9:00 am and 3:00 pm.
